“Happy With Clean, Comfortable Executive Room”

Needed to stay near the Sutherland Hospital for a night and chose an executive room (top of the range) at the Metro Inn. Friendly helpful reception at check in. Happy with the room which was spacious and quite decently refurbished to at least the 3 1/2 star rating standard it is given. It was well equipped with a microwave, bar fridge, really good quality kettle and toaster, and well above average crockery and cutlery. There were the promised views although you need to be on the small concrete balcony or standing up in the room near the windows to see it.
